




New cases and open cases

■ New cases ■ Open cases (on 31/12)




Finished proceedings in 2022





Method of appointment of arbitrators in 2022



Gender of arbitrators appointed by the parties/co-arbitrators in 2022





Gender of arbitrators appointed through the list procedure in 2022



Gender of arbitrators appointed directly by the NAI in 2022


