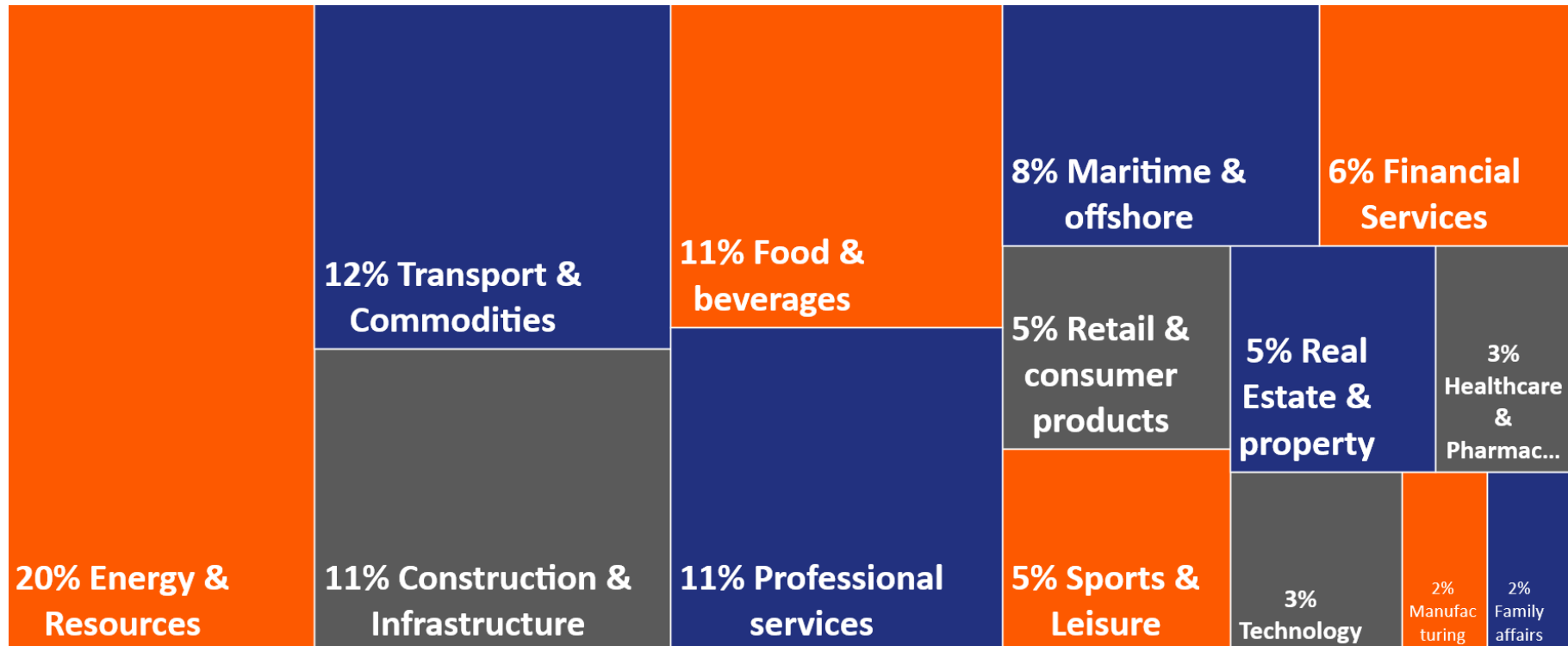

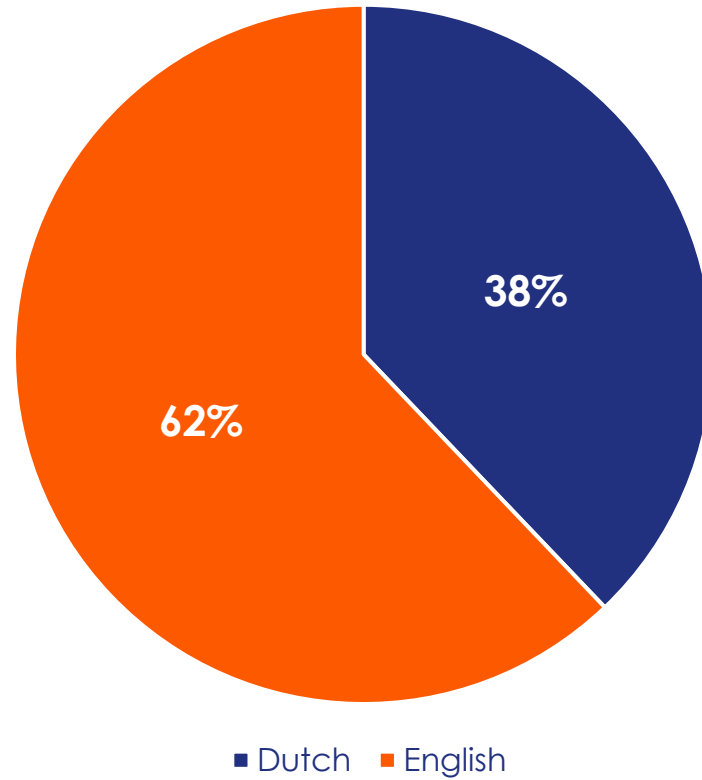

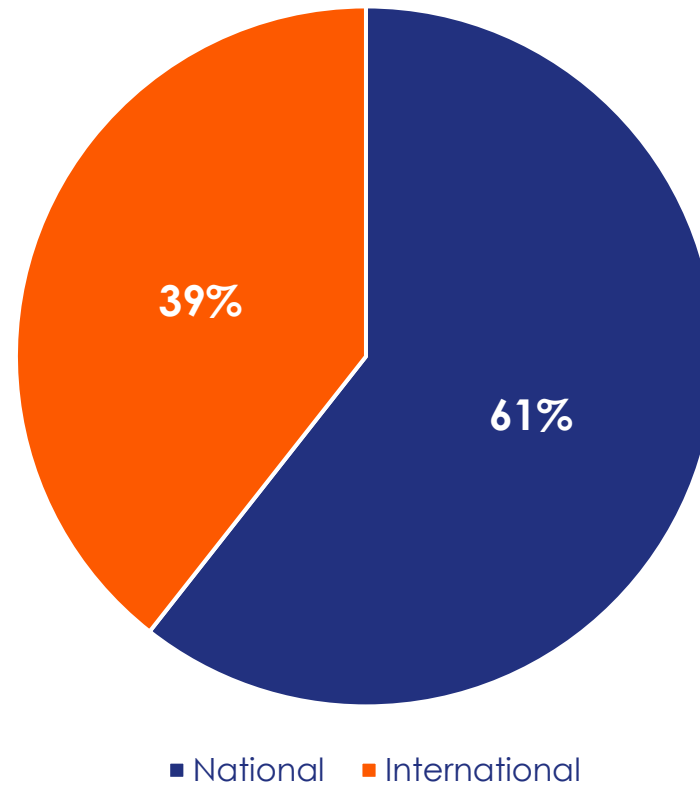

Language of proceedings in 2023*



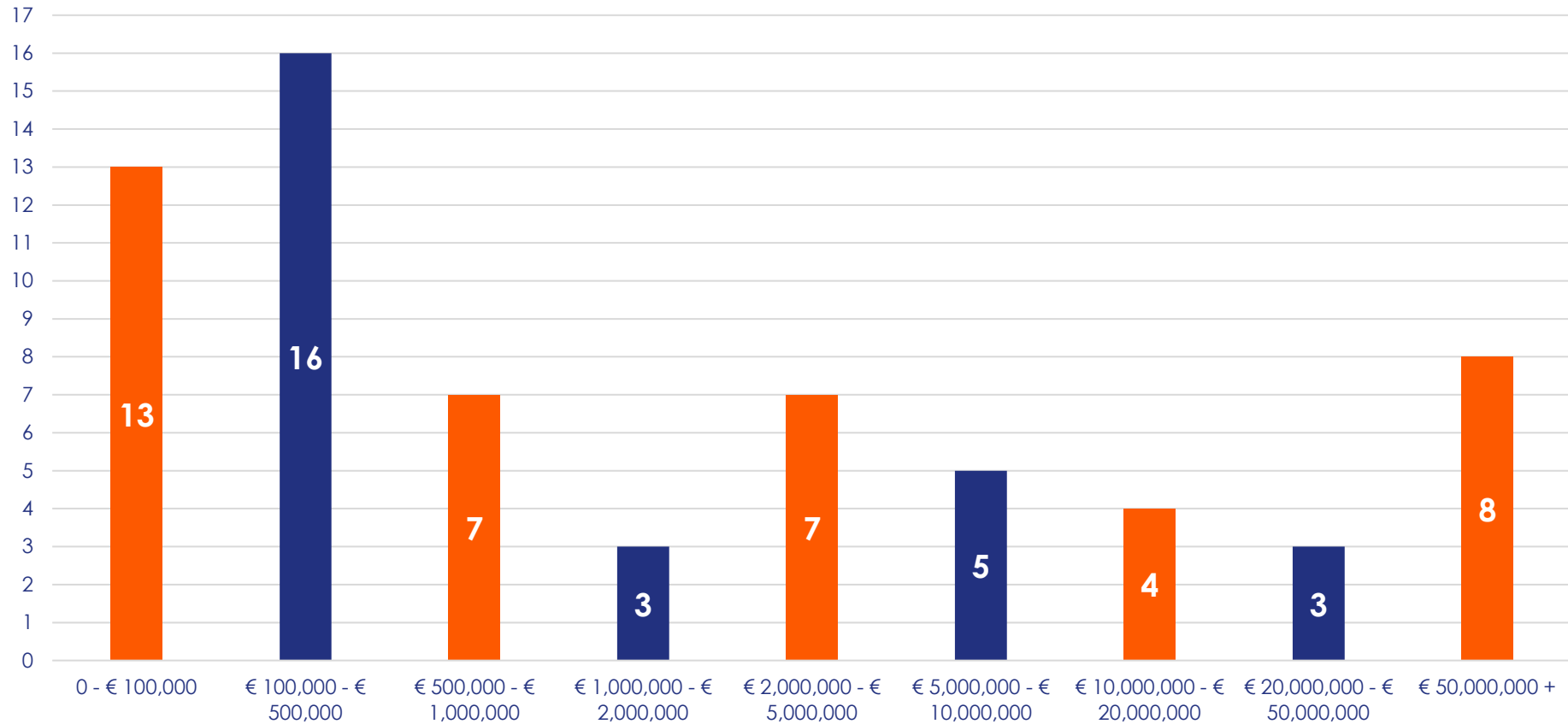

National and international cases in 2023*



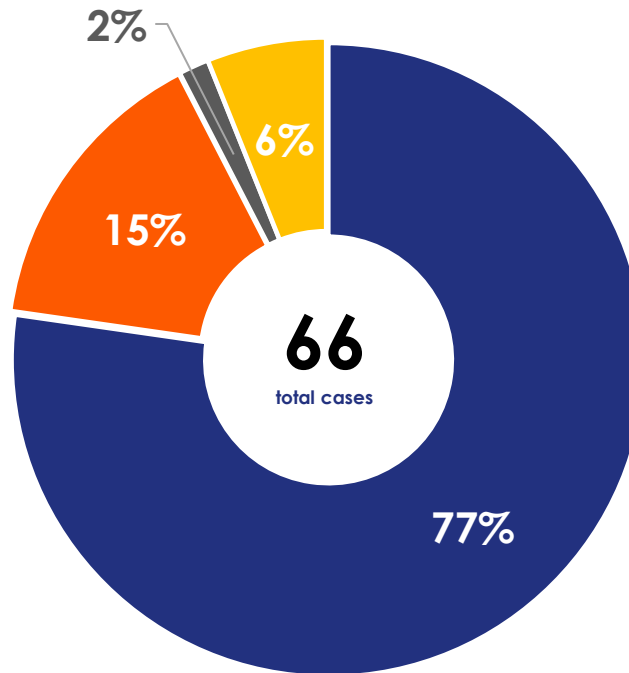

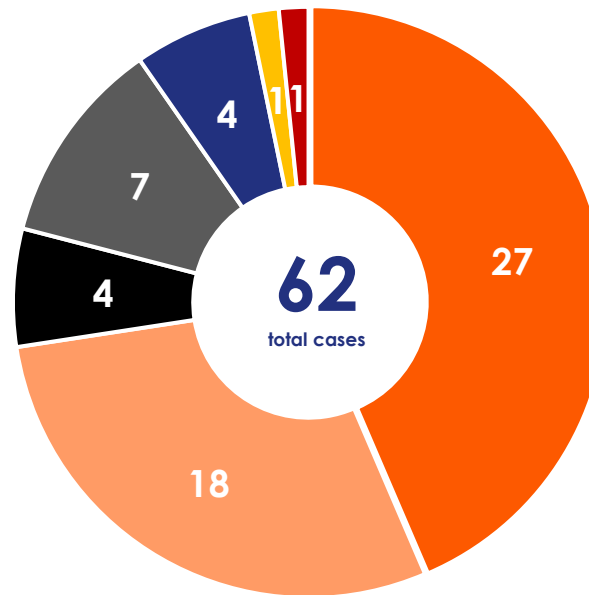

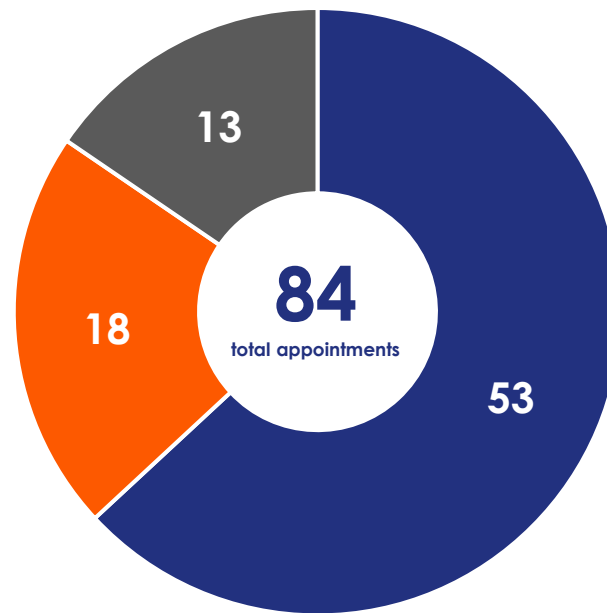

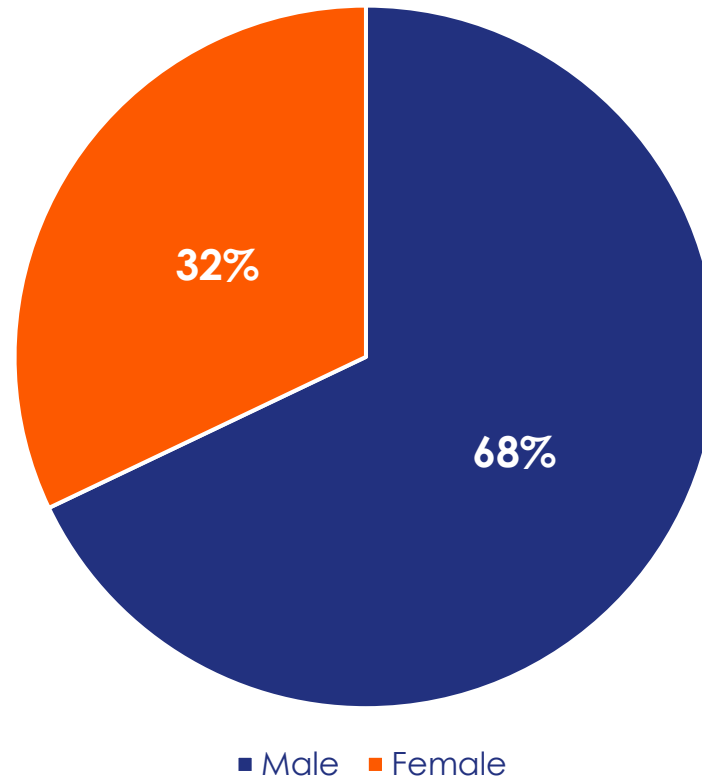
Method of appointment of arbitrators in 2023*

- Appointed by the NAI

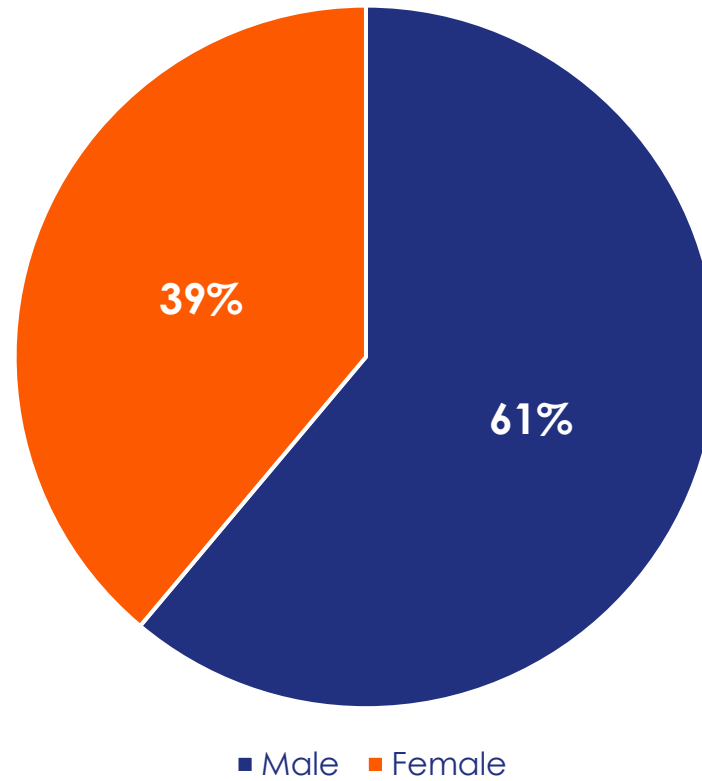

Gender of arbitrators appointed by the parties/co-arbitrators in 2023



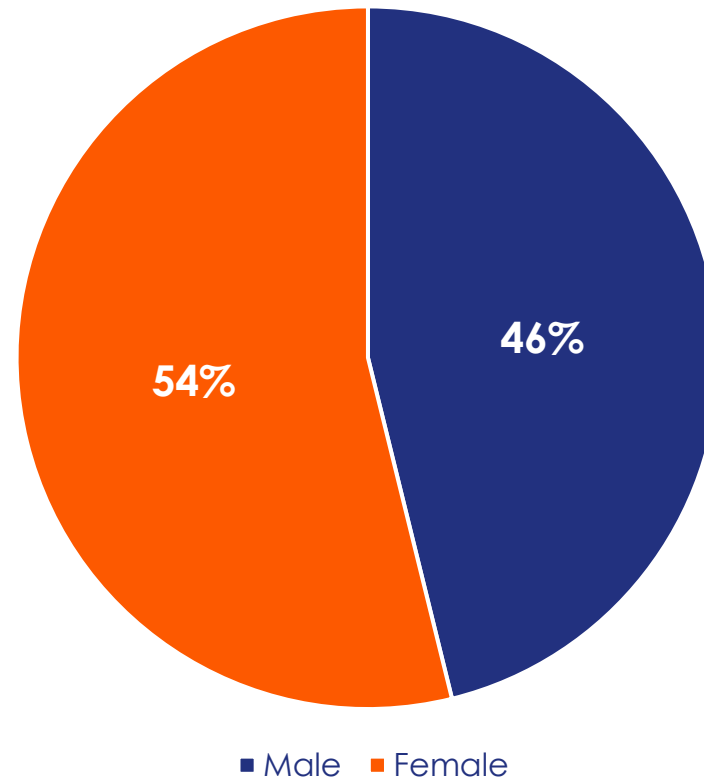
